WORSHIP NOTES

We welcome Faith Albis from Loma Linda Academy playing the prelude for first service. Participating in the baptism during second service this morning is Ethan's grandfather, Ed Zinke. The anthem is an arrangement, by contemporary American composer Mark Schweizer of a hymn text by Samuel Crossman, written in 1664, titled "My Song Is Love Unknown." It is a beautiful meditation on Christ's sacrifice for our salvation.

An Invitation to Give

Earlier this year, a decision was made to discontinue the use of our pipe organ due to electronic control issues which caused loud outbursts from the instrument. Though it has been unusable during our worship services for several months, progress has been made behind the scenes to return it to service.

An investigative look at the instrument has revealed the need for a number of repairs and refurbishments, beyond the scope of its electronic controls. The Church Board has authorized the Finance Committee to oversee this process and move toward a solution. We're pleased to announce that this week, in consultation with the organ technician who has cared for the organ since its installation, the Church Board has voted a plan for organ refurbishment.

A fund has been established where donations can be directed, and we are asking for your participation in this project. The timing of the repairs may allow for a portion of the organ to be returned to service in the near term until more permanent repairs and refurbishment can be completed. Beyond the scope of the instrument itself, the timing of this project will also allow us to address several other significant needs at the front of the church, including repairs and improvements to our audio infrastructure and our platform.

Gifts may be designated to this project by marking your offering envelope with the word "Organ." Those who use online giving will notice the organ fund in the top section under Local Church. Thank you for your gifts. Your generosity will enable us to be faithful stewards of the house of God in which we worship this morning.
