Holiday Food Drive

It's time again for our annual Food Drive to support needy families in our congregation and community. This year, because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, we are doing things a little bit differently than usual. Instead of the Pathfinders collecting donations from the community around the church, we are asking each of you to get involved. You can support the food drive in one of the following ways:

1. Collect donations from your neighbors.

Paper bags are available at the church office for your neighbors to fill with their donations. Each bag has a list of requested food items attached, along with instructions for returning the filled bags. Please take as many bags as you need, and leave one with each of your neighbors. They can drop off their filled bags at the church, or you can ask them to drop off their filled bags at your house, or collect them directly from your neighbors. If you decide to pick up donations or ask your neighbors to drop them off at your house, we ask that you make sure any expired items are removed before dropping them off at the church.

2. Donate food items directly.

You can also donate non-perishable food items such as macaroni and cheese, canned vegetables (corn, green beans, carrots, peas, etc.), boxed cereal (corn flakes, Cheerios, Frosted Mini Wheats, etc), canned fruit (peaches, pears, apples, etc.), canned soup (vegetable, minestrone, chicken noodle, cream

of mushroom or celery, etc.), rice (bags or boxes), stuffing, instant mashed potatoes, gravy mixes, cranberry sauce, muffin or corn bread mix, packaged bread crumbs, pie crust mix and fillings, just to name a few suggestions.

Bring your donations to the church before December 12. Donations can be dropped off by the entrance door under the portico on the north side of the building.

Please make sure that all items have their original labels, and that items are not expired. **All donations must be dropped off at the church no later than December 12 or delivered in person between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on December 13.**

Christmas Toy Drive for Kids at Shady Grove Hospital

Every year, the Spencerville Seventh-day Adventist Church partners with Shady Grove Adventist Hospital to provide toys for children hospitalized during the Christmas season. Being away from home during the holidays can be tough for kids, but your generosity can help make their experience a little bit brighter. Here are a few ideas for some of the most requested items: Barbies (fashion dolls), action figures/superheroes, small toddler toys, stuffed animals (12-15 inches tall, no beanie babies), Megablocks/Duplos, small Lego sets, Paw Patrol items, teenage coloring books, Big Mo's toy baby cars (other cars of this size), baby socks, sensory infant books, baby rattles/toys.

You can participate in any of the following ways:

1. Bring your new, unwrapped donations to the church no later than December 12, or deliver them in person between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on December 13.

2. Make a monetary donation, either by check or online at www.spencervillechurch.org. Be sure to mark your donation with “Christmas Toy Drive.”

3. Purchase your items online, through retailers such as Amazon, Walmart, etc. and have them delivered to the church to the attention of Brad Martin. If you decide to use this method, make sure that all items will be delivered no later than December 12!
