## Indoor, In-Person Worship Service

Note that the registration link will not become active until the Friday preceding the Sabbath that you plan to attend. All current Montgomery County COVID-19 protocols, such as wearing masks at all times on the property, must be followed. The COVID-19 protocol details are sent to those who pre-register for the worship service.
