A SPECIAL APPEAL FOR HAITI

Last Saturday, August 14, the island of Haiti was struck by a devastating 7.2 earthquake. Significant damage was done to the country's infrastructure; however, even more tragically, the number of lives lost has continued to climb. Reports out of Haiti number the death toll beyond 2,000.

When disasters happen abroad, ADRA, the Adventist Development and Relief Agency, is called to respond. As usual, they were one of the first relief agencies to arrive in Haiti after the earthquake. In addition to meeting the immediate needs of those impacted by the quake, ADRA's team works with the Adventist Hospitals in Haiti.
