COMMUNION NEXT SABBATH

“Do this in remembrance of Me.” A communion service is planned for September 11 during the 9:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. worship services. However, due to COVID, there will be several changes:

1. We invite you to enjoy the beauty of serving each other through the foot washing ceremony in your own homes either Friday night or Sabbath morning before you come to church. This beautiful ceremony connects us to Jesus and our church family by reminding us of a need for humble hearts. The one who is the greatest in Jesus’ kingdom is the one who serves. If you are a single person, consider opening your home to a couple friends to share this special time together.

2. In order to minimize contact, we are using prepackaged juice and bread. To avoid spills when opening the package, be careful to not squeeze the soft plastic cup too tightly.

3. The prepackaged communion cups will be available in the foyer prior to the communion service on Sabbath. If you are planning to participate virtually, you may pick up communion cups from the church office during regular office hours this next week. **If you are unable to get to the church, contact the church office and a deacon will deliver communion cups to your home.** Communion cups will also be available at

the front desk of Spencerville Academy. Prepackaged, gluten-free Communion bread is also available upon request.

4. Communion is a time for the refreshing of our hearts. Over the next week, pray for Jesus to open your eyes to anything that is between you and another—or between you and Him. Our prayer is that all of us will walk away from Communion deeply aware of the cleansing power of the blood of Jesus. We desire to function more like the Body of Christ with a clear vision of the work He would have us to do!
