MUSIC NOTES

Music in today's worship service features Spencerville Adventist Academy's High School Handbell Choir and Orchestra. The selected music is part of a concert that was performed by the SAA Music Department at the World Stage of the Museum of the Bible this past Wednesday. "Revelation" is an original composition which portrays the Apocalypse from the sixth chapter of the book of Revelation. Each of the four sections musically illustrate conquest, war, famine, and death. "Fantasy on Kingsfold" is based on an old English folk tune from the Middle Ages. The melody was first introduced as a hymn tune by Ralph Vaughn Williams in Sussex, England in 1906.

FREE FLU CLINIC TOMORROW

Flu season is upon us! We are partnering with Passport Health to offer basic flu vaccines to the church and the general public at no charge! We invite you to sign up and invite your family, friends, neighbors, and co-workers to this flu clinic **tomorrow, October 24, 2021, at Spencerville Church between 2:30 and 5:00 p.m.**

A high-dose flu vaccine is also available (primarily for those who are high-risk, aged

65 and older) for a nominal fee of \$25 at the time of the appointment. Again, the basic flu vaccine is free—only the high-dose vaccine has an up-charge. **Advance sign-up is necessary if you wish to participate as supplies are limited.** Registration is open at spencervillechurch.org/fluclinic.

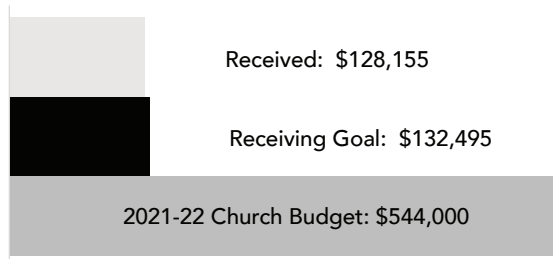
