Two weeks after the Christmas/New Year travel season, the board will reexamine the county's COVID-19 data and decide whether to extend or relax the mask policy. ## A HOLIDAY CRAFT EVENT

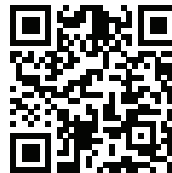
Join the ladies from Women's Ministries for a **Holiday Craft Event on November 18**

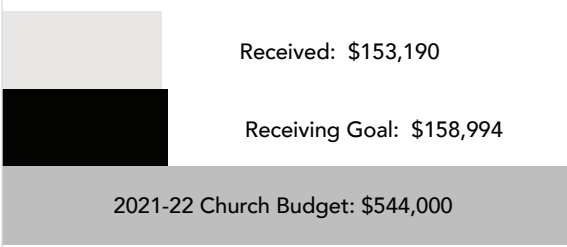
