AN IMPORTANT UPDATE ON MASKS, FOLLOWING A BOARD VOTE

On Wednesday, November 3, the church board voted unanimously to reinstate the requirement of masks, regardless of vaccination status, for all weekend services, children's activities, and weekday gatherings larger than ten people. Two weeks after the Christmas/New Year travel season, the board will reexamine the county's COVID-19 data and decide whether to extend or relax the mask policy.
