MUSIC NOTES

This morning, music for worship is brought by the Spencerville Chamber Singers. The group will sing arrangements of well known tunes in the sacred repertoire. The anthem, "The King of Love My Shepherd Is," comes from the prose of H.W. Baker. The tune has a tradition set in Ireland usually to the tune named "Dominus Regit Me", which is the melody heard this morning.

The choral introit "A Call to Worship" was recently composed, and is premiered this morning by Minister of Music, Michael Patterson.

The postlude, the "Little" Fugue in G minor by J.S. Bach, was composed by him sometime between 1703 and 1707, while he was employed as organist in Arnstadt, Germany, A fugue is a particularly crafty way of writing a piece of music that is based on a subject, stated by itself in one of the voices and then repeated many times, in various keys, by the other voices. It is played today to fulfill a request from Daniel Di Pinto (son of Mark and Katia) who became enamored with this fugue through a performance on YouTube and asked Mark Willey to learn and play it for him. Do you have a favorite piece of organ music you'd like to hear? Let us know.
