This tune is not foreign to Adventism, as it appears as No. 289 in the Adventist hymnal. The text and tune are both written by Ralph Carmichael with a copyright date of 1958. Carmichael is the composer behind several well-loved Adventist tunes such as "There is a Quiet Place" and "As We Come to You in Prayer".
