MUSIC NOTES

We are happy to welcome back the Concert Winds, Spencerville Adventist Academy's high school band, under the direction of Lisa Froelich. The postlude, "Flight of Valor," is based on the well-known hymn, "It Is Well With My Soul." In 1873, Horatio Spafford and his family, who lived in the United States, had plans to vacation in England. Due to business, he sent his wife and four daughters ahead, promising he would join them soon. Sadly, the ship, Ville de Havre, collided with another vessel and sank within minutes. Spafford's wife was one of few survivors. All four daughters were lost at sea. Spafford, as he sailed near the location where his daughters had perished, wrote the poem we know so well:

When peace, like a river, attendeth my way,
When sorrows like sea billows roll,
The clouds be rolled back as a scroll,
Whatever my lot, thou hast taught me to say,
It is well, it is well, with my soul...

And, Lord, haste the day when our faith shall be sight
The clouds be rolled back as a scroll,
The trumpet shall sound, and the Lord shall descend;
Even so, it is well with my soul...

This composition also was written in memory of another story—the story of those on United Flight 93 who tragically lost their lives in a Pennsylvania field on September 11, 2001. The composer dedicated this piece to their bravery and the heroic efforts which saved thousands of lives. You'll hear the reflective and somber music of "It Is Well With My Soul," which soon transitions to an intense section of peril, where the music changes between six different time signatures, eventually ending in triumph.

AN IMPORTANT UPDATE REGARDING MASKS AT SPENCERVILLE CHURCH

As you may have heard, Montgomery County lifted its indoor mask requirement this past Tuesday, February 22, while also noting that "businesses and organizations can continue to require customers or visitors to wear a mask in their establishments." Since the outset of the pandemic nearly two years ago, the Spencerville Church Board has been tasked with making policy decisions that incorporate input from local health organizations, medical professionals, as well as feedback from the pastoral staff and leaders in their specific areas of ministry. The board meets monthly to review how our COVID policy is being implemented, taking into account the latest statistics from the state of Maryland and Montgomery County. Our monthly church board meeting will take place this coming Monday, February 28. The board will reexamine the COVID-19 data and decide whether to extend or relax the mask policy at this time. At some point in the future, by God's grace, the policy will change and for many of us, masks will be but a memory. However, there may be those in our midst who choose to continue wearing a mask for any number of reasons. Our goal

must be to provide a safe place for people to grow spiritually and relationally, free of assumption and without fear of judgment or ridicule—mask or no mask. Your help is needed to ensure that Spencerville remains a place where people from all backgrounds can come together in worship while continuing to grow into who Jesus has called them to be.
