CHURCH/SCHOOL LIFE

MASK MANDATE LIFTED; HOWEVER, MASKS ARE STILL RECOMMENDED FOR THE IMMUNOCOMPROMISED AND UNVACCINATED

The Spencerville Church Board voted to lift the indoor mask mandate on Sunday, March 6. This date was chosen as it is a full two weeks after Montgomery County lifted the indoor mask mandate. **Today, March 19, is the second Sabbath where masks will no longer be required for indoor activities (including Sabbath School classes and worship services).** Spencerville Church continues to recommend masks for those who are immunocompromised, unvaccinated, or those who may feel more comfortable wearing a mask, as studies show that properly fitted N95 and KN95 masks provide a reasonable level of protection.

Our goal is that Spencerville Church remains a safe place for people to grow spiritually and relationally, free of assumption and without fear of judgment or ridicule—mask or no mask. Your help is needed to ensure that Spencerville remains a place where people from all backgrounds can come together in worship while continuing to grow into who Jesus has called them to be. 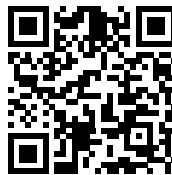
