MUSIC NOTES

Today's anthem is sung by the Spencerville Chamber Singers. The song is entitled Grace, which is an arrangement by American composer Mark Hayes. Hayes uses the text of "Amazing Grace" by John Newton as it's traditionally heard (Adventist hymnal, No. 108), but sets the text to the tune of a traditional folk song called "O Waly, Waly." The origins of this tune date back to the middle of the 18th century, and it is often debated as to whether is originates out of Scotland or England.

This tune can be found as a reference in the Adventist hymnal, No. 397, "An Upper Room". The melodic and harmonic direction of Hayes' rendition of Amazing Grace is a wonderful journey of the experience of being freed from the burdens of sin and breathing in the mercy and grace of God's love.

MASK MANDATE LIFTED, HOWEVER MASKS ARE STILL RECOMMENDED FOR THE IMMUNOCOMPROMISED AND UNVACCINATED

The Spencerville Church Board voted to lift the indoor mask mandate this past Sunday, March 6. This date was chosen as it is a full two weeks after Montgomery County lifted the indoor mask mandate. Today, March 12, is the first Sabbath where masks will no longer be required for indoor activities (including Sabbath School classes and worship services). Spencerville Church continues to recommend masks for those who are immunocompromised, unvaccinated, or those who may feel more comfortable wearing a mask, as studies show that properly fitted N95 and KN95 masks provide a reasonable level of protection.

Our goal is that Spencerville Church remains a safe place for people to grow spiritually and relationally, free of assumption and without fear of judgment or ridiculemask or no mask. Your help is needed to ensure that Spencerville remains a place where people from all backgrounds can come together in worship while continuing to grow into who Jesus has called them to be.
