Welcome to worship on this Resurrection Sabbath! This weekend we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus. What better way than to make a joyful noise of praise! This morning we welcome back the Spencerville Sanctuary Choir and Orchestra. The music sung tells a combined story of the of the joy and praise we offer unto God for the great sacrifice he made for us.

Included most notably is Ludwig van Beethoven's Hallelujah Chorus. This comes from his oratorio "Christ on the Mount of Olives". The work, which premiered in 1803, tells the story of Jesus' mission on Earth right into the death and resurrection. The final chorus is an exclamation

at the miracle that saved all of mankind. The original text is in German, however, the choir will sing the song in English. The English translation reads:

“Hallelujah! Hallelujah unto God’s almighty Son!  
Praise the Lord, ye bright angelic choir, in holy songs of joy!  
Man proclaims his grace and glory.  
Hallelujah unto God’s almighty Son.  
Praise the Lord in holy songs of joy!”

One final notable point is that the Anthems “*When I Survey*” and “*Amazing Grace*”, along with the brass fanfare of “*Praise, My Soul, the King of Heaven*” were orchestrated by James Bingham, previous choir director at Spencerville Church.
