MUSIC NOTES

For worship music this morning we welcome Sofya Puyul and Sonia Yatsyshyna. Sonia is a sophomore cello major at Washington Adventist University and Sofya is a recent graduate from the class of 2022. Joined at the piano by Minister of Music, Michael Patterson, the three musicians will perform Michael's arrangement of *Jesus Loves Me*.

Well known by the Adventist denomination, *Jesus Loves Me* is a song which harkens all the way back to 1862. The tune BRADBURY was composed by William B. Bradbury after he took a poem assembled by Anna B. Warner. The text points to references in Provers 8:17. The idea of the lyrics first appeared as a poem in the context of an 1860 novel called *Say and Seal*, written by her older sister Susan, in which the words were spoken as a comforting poem to a sick child. Warner allegedly thought the poem to be fitting from the point of view as a "child of God," singing in regards to the heavenly Father, a theme perfect for Father's Day weekend. The tune has become associated with children to this day.
