MUSIC NOTES

This Sabbath, we welcome Karla Rivera-Curtis back to the platform. Karla is a renowned soprano who is no stranger to the Spencerville community. She has and continues to perform globally and teaches at Washington Adventist University as part of the voice faculty.

The two songs she sings as a part of worship today are Were You There? as arranged by Moses Hogan and Above All by Lenny Leblanc and Paul Baloche.

Above All is a commonly heard tune in contemporary praise but is also beautiful and inspirational in a worship anthem setting. The tune, commonly attributed to Michael W. Smith, was co-written by country and worship songwriters Lenny LeBlanc and Paul Baloche in 1999. The song was placed on Smith's "Worship" album in 2001 and won a Dove Award for "Inspirational Recorded Song of the Year."

Today, Pastor Matthew preaches about our need to understand and accept the grace of God for ourselves. At the cross, Jesus faced ridicule and rejection from those that he came to save. What prevented them from understanding and accepting Jesus, the most beautiful manifestation of the grace of God? Interestingly, the same phenomenon that prevented others from receiving Jesus as Savior in those days prevents many from receiving Him today. Above All is a beautiful musical depiction of how Jesus felt, as described in Pastor Matthew's sermon.
