MUSIC NOTES

The music for worship this week involves many participants. Nikolai and Keri Tomenko will play the Gigue from Albert Stoessel's "*Suite Antique*". The Suite Antique was written in 1924 by the American composer, Stoessel. The Gigue is a joyful duet that involves back and forth responses from the two violins. Michael Patterson will accompany the Tomenkos.

After that, Jasmin Crossfield sings "*The Lord is My Light*", composed by Frances Allitzen. She will be accompanied by Mark Di Pinto. Mary Allitzen, later to go by her middle name, Frances, wrote this tune in 1897, where it later became her most popular composition. The song puts the hopeful Psalm 27 to music. In this song, you will hear the confident and forthright approach to the text that David once put to word. The text reads:

"The Lord is my light and my salvation. Whom, then shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life. Of whom then shall I be afraid? Though a host of men were laid against me, yet shall not my heart be afraid; And tho' there rose up war against me, yet will I put my trust in Him. For in the time of trouble, He shall hide me in His tabernacle. Yea, in the secret places of His dwelling shall He hide me, And set me up upon a rock of stone."
