## **MUSIC NOTES**

Today, we're pleased to welcome Aaron Tucker and Jason West to the platform. Aaron, no stranger to Spencerville Church, is a renowned tenor in the DMV area. He has a long history of singing for Spencerville worship along with his regular participation in the sanctuary choir.

Jason West is a local organist and composer who has written and arranged a plethora of choral, instrumental, and organ works. Jason has played for our worship services several times, and we are grateful for his presence today while Michael Patterson and Mark Willey are traveling.

The anthems selected for this service contain a common thread— seeking God's love and mercy. Matthew 23:23 mentions the "most important matters of the law [are] justice, mercy and faithfulness." In Elijah (the oratorio composed by Felix Mendelssohn), the character Obadiah sings: "If with all your heart ye truly seek Me, Ye shall ever surely find Me, Thus saith our God" (Deuteronomy 4:29). When seeking out God's character, we find the trait of mercy, aptly described in the text of today's anthem, "There's a Wideness in God's Mercy," written by William Faber in 1854. Dr. Michael Hawn from the Perkins School of Theology states, "The theme of this hymn is based on the premise that a sovereign God, unlike earthly rulers, demonstrates welcome, kindness, grace and mercy. All we need to do is have a simple faith that 'rest[s] upon God's word." The text reads:

There's a wideness in God's mercy, like the wideness of the sea. There's a kindness in God's justice, which is more than liberty.

There is welcome for the sinner, and more graces for the good.

There is mercy with the Savior, there is healing in his blood.

For the love of God is broader than the measures of the mind, and the heart of the Eternal is most wonderfully kind.
