# **MUSIC NOTES**

Welcome to Spencerville Church for this momentous and glorious season: Easter! For worship today, we welcome the Spencerville Church Sanctuary Choir and Orchestra to paint a musical picture of the story of salvation through the death and resurrection of our Lord.

The first of three anthems come from the oratorio "The Creation" (German: Die Schöpfung) by Franz Joseph Haydn. As the title portrays, this monumental work paints the picture of Creation as scripture portrays. Excerpted from the oratorio is "The Heavens are Telling." This movement presents a narrative chorus of angels telling the story of creation. The archangels Gabriel, Uriel, and Raphael sing as a trio in the middle.

The second anthem can be found in the Seventh-day Adventist Hymnal, No. 154, "When I Survey The Wondrous Cross." This beloved hymn poetically and musically paints a picture of human emotion in response to the great sacrifice upon the Cross. The original text of this hymn was written by Isaac Watts in 1707 and was later set to music by Edward Miller (1790) to the famous tune HAMBURG, a tune Adventists know and love globally. The rendition performed for today's service is a world premiere by Minster of Music, Michael Patterson, composed specially for the Spencerville Sanctuary orchestra and choir.

The third and final anthem is a Sanctuary Choir favorite, "My Eternal King," by Jane Marshall. This dramatic and triumphant musical story is a response to the death of Christ. The text is a declaration of love and adoration to God that exclaims "I love Thee and will love...solely because Thou art my God and Eternal King." The text is taken from an anonymous 17th-century Latin text that was set to music by Jane Marshall.
