MUSIC NOTES

For worship this week, we welcome the Spencerville Sanctuary Choir for the final time this season. They are singing a sample piece from what will be enjoyed during tonight's Evensong Concert, which features both the Sanctuary choir and orchestra. Joining the choir for worship is soprano soloist, Juliana Baioni, no stranger to the Spencerville community. Juliana was raised in this area and is an alumnus of both Spencerville Adventist Academy and Washington Adventist University. Juliana currently lives in Southern California and works for La Sierra University.

Our anthem today is the first movement from Franz Schubert's Mass in G Major. Written in 1815, the mass was composed by an 18-year-old Schubert in less than six days. The Kyrie is a set of text that can be thought of as a prayer which pleads for God's mercy upon us. Today the piece will be sung in its original Latin. The text reads:
