MUSIC NOTES

Joining us this morning is soprano Karla Rivera. She has a long history of music-making here at Spencerville, with many solo and choral appearances going back to her time as a student at Washington Adventist University. In addition to her many solo singing engagements, she is the Director of Music at the Church of the Little Flower in Bethesda, Maryland. The anthem "I Will Sing New Songs of Gladness" is one of the ten "Biblical Songs" (Opus 99) composed by Czech composer Antonín Dvořák. Inspired by Psalms of the Old Testament during his stay in America (1892-95), Dvořák penned these deeply personal and introspective pieces on his return to his homeland in 1894.

Like the entire opus, this piece departs from his earlier folk-inspired style. "I Will Sing New Songs" showcases Dvořák's ability to create a profound, prayerful atmosphere, subtly underlining the spiritual longing expressed in the lyrics. The musical structure reflects the Psalm's text, with the voice leading and modulations revealing Dvořák's exceptional sensitivity to the text. He beautifully illustrates the human relationship to the divine, making "I Will Sing New Songs" and the entire Biblical Songs opus enduring contributions to the sacred art song repertoire.
