The piece "Come, Blessed Savior," comes from French composer Camille Saint-Saëns, a musical prodigy known for his remarkable career in late 19th and early 20th-century Paris. After serving as a church organist, he found success as a freelance pianist and composer, celebrated in Europe and the Americas.
