# **MUSIC NOTES**

The choral anthem this morning is by John Newton, the mariner turned minister, and author of the hymn 'Amazing Grace', who lived a life of profound transformation. His early life at sea, which began at eleven, led him to the brutal world of the slave trade. An enforced enlistment, a disgraceful desertion, and a stint on a slave ship marked his early adult years. Finding solace in Thomas Kempis's 'Imitation of Christ' amidst inhuman conditions, Newton's spiritual awakening began. After narrowly escaping death in a violent storm, he pledged his life to Christ, eventually rising to the rank of Captain. He left seafaring after seven years, dedicating himself to ministry.

As a preacher in Olney and London for over four decades, Newton remained acutely aware of his past and his redemption. His writing on spiritual transformation asserted that only divine intervention could lift the scales from human eyes. Newton's personal testimony on the atrocities of the slave trade was heard by King George III, contributing to the abolition of the trade through acts of parliament in 1807 and 1808, and its complete cessation by 1833. His self-penned epitaph in St. Mary Woolnoth, London, succinctly captures his journey: from an "infidel and libertine, a servant of slaves in Africa" to one "restored, pardoned, and appointed to preach the gospel he had long labored to destroy."
