MUSIC NOTES

Our vocal soloist this morning is Denique Isaac. She received her music degrees from Washington Adventist University (WAU) and Indiana University. She is active in various voles in opera and oratorio performance.

The opening hymn is a tune you have likely heard, named "Jerusalem." It was perhaps most famous in the popular culture for its use in the film "Chariots of Fire" but the hymn "Jerusalem" is often sung as a kind of sacred British National Anthem. The text that is set in our hymnal seeks to express the vast majesty of God.

The call to prayer is a hymn that you can find (and follow along with) in our hymnal as hymn number 81. It was composed by Spencerville member James Bingham, who served as chair of the music department at WAU for many years, as well as being our choral director for 17 years. He composed this hymn for the publication of the current Seventh-day Adventist hymnal, naming the tune Janelle, his wife's name.

The anthem is based on the ultimate Biblical love song, Song of Solomon, chapter 2, verses 10-12. Often interpreted as an allegory depicting God's relationship to his people, Song of Solomon is a unique book in the Biblical canon.
