MUSIC NOTES

Our soloist for second service is Karla Rivera. She serves as Director of Music at the Church of the Little Flower, in Bethesda, Maryland, and Alumni Director at WAU. She is also active as a soloist and voice teacher.

The Canterbury Dictionary of Hymnology, written by Dr. Carlton Young, suggests that "Let us break bread together" was a "spiritual formed in the West African Gullah/Geechee slave culture that developed in the coastal areas of South-Eastern colonial America, including St Helena Island, Beaufort, and Charleston, South Carolina". As with all the spirituals, the composer of this tune, and the writer of its text, is unknown. That this great music emerged out of slavery is a testament to the endurance of the human spirit. This song encourages us to break bread, drink, and pray together. As with many of the African American Spirituals, there is often a double meaning, with instructions for the underground railroad, and encouragement to fellow slaves that could be sung openly. This entire canon of music shines through to our time as an inspiration to make beauty out of whatever hardships we may experience in life.
