MUSIC NOTES

The Spencerville Church Summer Sanctuary Choir is in the loft for our second service this morning for the last of their "Summer Sabbaths." The regular choral year will begin with a rehearsal on Wednesday, September 13 and regular worship leadership twice per month. Singing in the choir is an amazingly fulfilling way to participate in the life of this church. Please prayerfully consider joining.

"In today's service, the choir sings two anthems by contemporary American composer Gilbert Martin based on 19th-century hymn tunes: "Sweet Hour of Prayer" and "Sing, Sweet Song." The words for "Sweet Hour of Prayer" were penned by William Walford, an English preacher, in 1845, while the music was composed by William Bradbury a few years later. The song's structure and melodic progression are representative of the early 19th-century Protestant hymnody in America, marked by its directness and emotional clarity. "Sing, Sweet Song" bears the tune name "Cincinnati" and was first published in the 1813 edition of "The Western Harmony" compiled by Freeman Lewis.
