Written by Isaac Watts, the Congregational preacher and prolific hymn writer, it is considered by some hymnologists to be the greatest hymn in the English language. Each word of this text is replete with significance. With the final line of the last stanza, one of the most moving in all of hymnody, Watts observes for all of us that such amazing love "demands my soul, my life, my all." Joshua Fit the Battle of Jericho is an African American Spiritual that depicts the story of Joshua's incredible battle at Jericho.
