MUSIC NOTES

Robert Martinez is the vocal soloist this morning. No stranger to our church and school community, Robert served for many years on the music faculty of Spencerville Adventist Academy, before becoming Vice Principal of High School. The anthem, sung during the distribution of the elements, is "*Panis Angelicus*" by César Franck. The text of this communion hymn was written by the prominent theologian St. Thomas Aquinas and dates back to the 13th century. Francks musical setting, with it's long, sustained phrases, brings an uplifting, ethereal quality to the text, capturing the transcendent nature of communion. "*Panis Angelicus*" remains one of Franck's most beloved works, frequently performed for church and concert settings.
