MUSIC NOTES

Heaven is a central theme in the spirituals of enslaved Africans, signifying longing, deliverance, and liberation. Phrases like "Deep river, my home is over Jordan" express this yearning, while "I've got a robe, you've got a robe, All God's children got a robe" visualizes heavenly rewards. Heaven is seen as a place of reunion with Jesus, as denoted in the line "I'm gonna sit at the welcome table." However, spirituals also emphasize judgment and resisting Satan's temptations.

Revelation 21:10–27 inspired the spiritual "I Want to Be Ready," also known as "Walk in Jerusalem Just Like John", portraying heaven's grandeur. Notably, African American scholar Wyatt Tee Walker explains that John's Revelation does not feature him walking in Jerusalem but observing a new celestial realm. This spiritual, with multiple variations, potentially has antebellum origins.
