MUSIC NOTES

We welcome the Spencerville Adventist Academy Concert Winds to our worship service for the first time this school year. Lisa Froelich, director, recently returned from maternity leave. During her absence, math teacher Brody Wiedemann stepped in as her substitute. "The guest conductor for the prelude is no stranger to the Spencerville community," Mrs. Froelich reports. "Mr. Wiedemann directed the band until my return on October 2. I want to offer deep appreciation to him for his hard work and the time he gave to introduce these pieces to the students."

"A Hymn Tune Rhapsody" is based on the touching hymn "Softly and Tenderly." The beauty of this lovely hymn tune is present from the simple statement in the beginning through the following joyous section and the majestic and stirring conclusion. "On An American Spiritual" is based on one of the earliest spirituals published in a hymn collection—"Were You There." In this arrangement, we might expect the plaintive opening of the well-known spiritual ("Were you there when they crucified my Lord?") and the majestic closing portions ("Were you there when He rose up from the dead?"), but the chaotic, brutal nature of the center section may seem significantly out of place until we remind ourselves of the center portion of this Easter lament, depicting the death of Jesus when they nailed Him to a tree and laid Him in the grave.
