MUSIC NOTES

The prelude and postlude this morning are played by Daniel Di Pinto, accompanied by his father, Mark. Both movements played are from a sonata for cello and piano by composer Bernhard Romberg (1767 – 1841) who was a German cellist and composer. The vocal soloists this morning are Regina Andrade and Ariana Parks. The Call to Prayer was inspired by the great Victorian era poet, Christina Rossetti. Our hymnal bears a number of her hymn texts and her sacred poetry has been often set to music as is the case with "None Other Lamb" a poem that observes the singularity the author finds in the graceful presence of Jesus. The anthem is by Ferdinand David, who was just one year younger than Felix Mendelssohn. Like Mendelssohn, David was raised Jewish but later converted to Protestant Christianity. When Mendelssohn died unexpectedly, David took over his post as Kapellmeister of the Gewandhaus Orchestra.
