# **MUSIC NOTES**

The hymn tune "Gloria" makes two appearances in our worship service this morning. The tune's origins come from a traditional French song, composer unknown, titled "*Les Anges dans nos compagnes*" (The Angels in our countryside). James Chadwick, an Irish priest, adapted the French lyrics, creating the hymn we now know as "*Angels We Have Heard on High.*" The choir sings an arrangement of this hymn by contemporary American composer Howard Helvey (b. 1968), who created a jubilant accompaniment for piano, four hands. In 1889, French composer Eugene Gigout published a collection of 10 pieces for organ. Among them is a piece titled "*Rhapsodie sur de Noëls*," considered to be a mashup of several popular French Christmas tunes. The piece includes songs that might be less familiar to American listeners, but it's hard to miss the fanfare strains of "Gloria" that bring the piece to a fanfare ending.


