MUSIC NOTES

The lyrics to the hymn "*The Love of God*" were written by German-born hymn writer and minister Frederick M. Lehman (1868–1953) in 1917. The lyrics of the third stanza were found written on the wall of a patient's room in an insane asylum or on a cell wall in a prison. Whatever the circumstances, the lyrics were etched on the wall as a reminder of the greatness of God's love. In due time, he died and the men who had the job of repainting his cell were impressed by the words. Before their paint brushes had obliterated them, one of the men jotted them down and thus they were preserved. Over 200 years later, Frederick M. Lehman came across these words and was deeply moved by the message. He expanded on the initial lines and incorporated them into the hymn "*The Love of God*." The third stanza is known for its powerful depiction of the unfathomable nature of God's love and continues to be sung in churches around the world. Will you let God lavish you with His inexhaustible love today?
