## **MUSIC NOTES**

C.S. Lewis, in his book "Reflections on the Psalms" wrote "The most valuable thing the Psalms do for me is to express the same delight in God which made David dance." Psalm 100, with its five verses and 87 words, is the sixth shortest Psalm in the Bible, but its focused, concise themes of praise to God have made it one of the most frequent of the Psalms to be set to music, from ancient times to today. When Latin was used as the language of the church, this text was known as the "Jubilate Deo" (Rejoice in God) and practically every composer of sacred music has set this text. The choir sings two settings of this Psalm in our service. The first is by American composer Dale Wood (1934-2003), a renowned organist, and choral director who served as a church musician on the west coast. The second, "O be joyful in the Lord" is by one of the most well-loved composers of sacred choral music, John Rutter (b. 1945). Both settings intersperse outbursts of jubilant praise from the choir, with sparkling accompaniment from the organ in attempts to musically reflect the great statement of praise and worship found in Psalm 100.
