The annual constituency meeting for Spencerville Adventist Academy (SAA) will be held on Monday, May 6 at 7:00 p.m. As the constituent church of SAA, we are responsible for selecting delegates to represent our church and vote on the reports and matters brought before this constituency meeting. To build this delegation, we are asking you to nominate TWO members of Spencerville Church to be considered by the church for representation. This is a nomination, not a vote. The vote happens, before the entire church congregation, at the second reading presentation of the selected individuals. Therefore, please do not write a name down twice or encourage others to write down one name multiple times; a person's name only needs to appear once for that individual to be nominated. Each name will then be considered based on the qualifications provided in the Seventh-Day Adventist Church Manual. Nominations must be submitted by tomorrow at 11:59 p.m. Please note that only baptized church members of the Spencerville Church can serve as delegates at this meeting. The pastors of the Spencerville Church; teachers and faculty of SAA; and SAA school board members are already designated as "ex-officio" members of the meeting, so please do not nominate any of these individuals. DONATIONS NEEDED FOR CHILDREN'S HOME

In late February, Spencerville Church hosted a seminar on human trafficking led by our own Amanda Rodriguez. Amanda is the director of Turn Around, Inc., which provides counseling, support, and advocacy for victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, and more.

Turn Around is working to open a home for trafficked children in the greater Baltimore area. The home will serve 8 children at a time and will also house the staff needed for counseling and supervision. Amanda has provided a list of things needed to make this home a warm and welcoming place for these children who have already endured so much. Please prayerfully consider giving to this worthy cause.

Needed items include:

- Twin bedding (sheets, pillows, pillowcases, blankets, bedspreads)
- Towels, hand towels, and washcloths
- Place settings (dishes, glasses, flatware, cups)
- Shelf-stable food items (catsup, mayonnaise, mustard, salt, pepper, sugar, etc.)
- Cooking supplies (pots, pans, mixing bowls, cooking utensils, cookie sheets, hot pads)
- Kitchen items (can opener, trash can, trash can liners, paper towels, dish soap)

- Cleaning supplies
- Hygiene products (soap, toothpaste, body wash, shampoo and conditioner, sanitary products, toilet paper)
