## MUSIC NOTES

The introit and anthem are excerpts from the “*Messiah*” Oratorio by G. F. Händel (1685-1759) and feature soloist tenor Aaron Tucker, accompanied by Cindy Wang (violin I), Keri Tomenko (violin II), Deric Tomenko (viola), Elise Welch (cello), and Mark Di Pinto (harpsichord). The pericope is based on Isaiah 40:1-4 which corresponds with the final theme of our sermon series from the book of Malachi. Fun fact: Händel composed the entire oratorio in London between August, 22 and September, 14 in 1741 (in just 24 days!), and premiered it in Dublin on April 13, 1742. While the oratorio initially received modest public reception, it has become one of the best-known and most frequently performed choral works in Western music today. To hear more Baroque music by Händel, you’ll want to attend our *Messiah* sing-a-long on December 14, 2024
