OUR 10-3-2 GIVING GOAL

"10-3-2" is the long-term financial goal for Spencerville Church as voted by our church board, in alignment with North American Division recommendations. It includes 10% of income to be returned as tithe, 3% of income be returned to the operating budget (sometimes referred to as the combined budget), and 2% of income to the capital budget. CAPITAL BUDGET GOAL

The church board, responding to a recommendation from the Finance Committee and then affirmed by the church in business session, voted to recommended a capital-giving goal of \$400,000 for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. Future bulletins will report on progress toward this goal. This \$400,000 will cover significant capital repairs beyond the scope of general church maintenance and cover our loan payment for the 29 acres surrounding our church facility. Additionally, the church voted in business session to initiate fundraising for a \$400,000 project to resurface and secure our parking lot. This results in an actual goal of \$800,000 needed to fund our Capital Budget for 2024-25.
