Our Spencerville Community Services Ministry has organized two ways in which you can give to the ongoing need in the Carolina Conference:

1. Donate Financially.

Every dollar donated through spencervillechurch.org/give then selecting "Helene Relief-Carolinas" will flow directly to the Adventist Community Services chapter in the Carolina Conference. They already have "boots on the ground" and are responding to the significant needs, especially in Western North Carolina.

2. Donate Critical Supplies.
