WORSHIP NOTES

Today's worship service concludes our nine-part "Ripening" series on the fruit of the Spirit. As we reflect on the culmination of this journey, the Sanctuary Choir will share an anthem by French composer Charles Gounod (1818-1893). Although Gounod is primarily remembered today for his operas, his sacred music was often held in even higher esteem during his lifetime. This anthem, featuring pericopes from Psalm 43:3-5 and Psalm 20:6-8, beautifully blends several virtues of the Spirit's fruit, crying out to the Lord for strength, light, and truth. As we worship together, may our worship service draw our hearts closer to the One who ripens our character through His Spirit.

Many of you have asked how you can help those impacted by Hurricane Helene.

Our Spencerville Community Services Ministry has organized two ways in which you can give to the ongoing need in the Carolina Conference:

1. Donate Financially.

Every dollar donated online through spencervillechurch.org/give (then selecting "Helene Relief-Carolinas") will flow directly to the Adventist Community Services chapter in the Carolina Conference. They already have "boots on the ground" and are responding to the significant needs, especially in Western North Carolina.

2. Donate Critical Supplies.

As we've spoken with those on the front lines of this disaster, we've tried to listen to what is most needed. The two largest needs are personal hygiene kits and household clean-up kits as people attempt to make their homes livable again.
