Orr has already initiated the permitting process for demolition and will be helping us vet qualified firms to submit proposals for master planning. While the past year may have felt quiet, much has happened behind the scenes, and we anticipate seeing visible progress in the coming months. Please continue to pray for our Building Committee and the Orr Partners team as we move forward together.
