

COMPARISON CHART

The True Trinity vs. The Counterfeit (Unholy) Trinity

TRUE (HOLY) TRINITY	COUNTERFEIT (UNHOLY) TRINITY	SCRIPTURE REFERENCES
God the Father: Source of authority and life; initiator of truth and salvation.	The Dragon (Satan): False 'father'; source of deception and power for the counterfeit trinity.	Revelation 12:9; 13:2: Dragon gives the beast 'his power and authority.'
Jesus Christ (the Son): Image of the Father; receives authority from Him (Matt. 28:18).	Sea Beast (from the Sea): Imitates the Son; looks like the Dragon ('two of a kind').	Revelation 13:1–2: Parody of the Father–Son relationship.
Christ's Death and Resurrection: 'The Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.'	Sea Beast's Fatal Wound and Healing: Counterfeit death and resurrection.	Revelation 13:3, 8: Mimics the cross and resurrection.
Christ's Ministry: Lasts 3½ years; marked by truth, humility, and redemption.	Sea Beast's Ministry: Lasts 42 months (3½ years); marked by blasphemy and deception.	Revelation 13:5: Counterfeit duration of Christ's ministry.
Holy Spirit: 'Another Comforter' (John 14:16); points to Christ; brings fire of truth (Acts 2).	Land Beast/False Prophet (from the Earth): 'Like a lamb' but speaks like a dragon; performs false miracles.	Revelation 13:11–14: Counterfeit of the Holy Spirit's work and Pentecost.
Holy Spirit gives life ('breath'): Brings genuine spiritual vitality to believers.	Land Beast gives 'breath' to the image: Gives false life that demands coerced worship.	Revelation 13:15: Uses same Greek word *pneuma* ('spirit').
God's Method: Persuasion through truth, love, and freedom.	Satan's Method: Persuasion through deception, counterfeit miracles, and force.	Revelation 13:14–17: Deception and coercion (forehead and hand).

TRUE (HOLY) TRINITY	COUNTERFEIT (UNHOLY) TRINITY	SCRIPTURE REFERENCES
True Pentecost: Fire from heaven empowers truth and unity.	Counterfeit Pentecost: Fire from heaven deceives through false revival.	Acts 2; Revelation 13:13– 14: Counterfeit spiritual outpouring.
True Worship: Based on Scripture, faith, and discernment.	False Worship: Based on sensory experience, emotion, and false miracles.	Revelation 13:8; 2 Thessalonians 2:9–10: Deception appeals to the senses.
The True God: Revealed in humility, sacrifice, and love.	The Counterfeit Godhead: Exalts self, uses spectacle, and demands allegiance.	Revelation 12–13; 16:13– 14: 'Unclean spirits like frogs' symbolize global deception.

SUMMARY

- The True Trinity works through truth, humility, love, and freedom.
- The Unholy Trinity operates through deception, coercion, counterfeit miracles, and false worship.
- In the end, the issue will be "Trinity versus trinity" worship of the Creator versus allegiance to the counterfeit.
