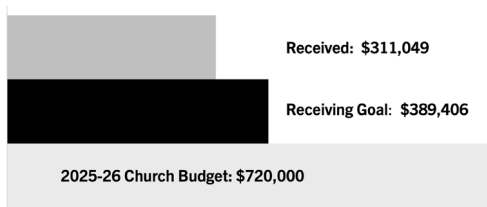

BE GENEROUS – GRACE THAT GROWS

“For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you by His poverty might become rich” — 2 Corinthians 8:9

BIG IDEA

Generosity does not begin with what we have—it begins with what Christ has already given. Grace received becomes generosity released.

MESSAGE SCRIPTURES

2 Corinthians 8:1–9
2 Corinthians 9:6–11
Luke 6:38
Luke 19:1-10

THOUGHTS ON GENEROSITY

- Christian generosity flows from grace.
- The Macedonian churches gave joyfully and sacrificially, even in poverty.
- Generosity is contagious—grace received inspires grace given in others.
- Tithes and Offerings are not numbers they are acts in the grace of generosity.

QUESTIONS

- Where have I experienced the generosity of Jesus most clearly in my life?
- What fears or hesitations keep me from living more open-handed?
- How might my generosity inspire faith and generosity in others?
