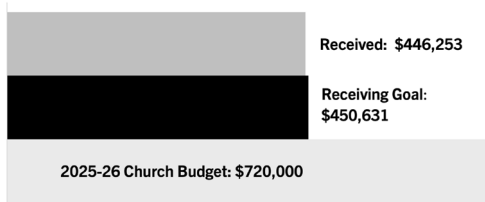

GOD'S LOVE STORY

“Let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell in their midst.” — Exodus 25:8

BIG IDEA The sanctuary is God pushing His way back in. In the courtyard, Jesus comes near through sacrifice. In the holy place, Jesus keeps us near through bread, light, and prayer. In the most holy place, Jesus makes us clean and ready—until the day the Lamb receives His bride.

MESSAGE SCRIPTURES

Exodus 25:8 • Romans 3:23 • Isaiah 59:2 • Romans 5:8–9 • John 1:29 • John 6:51
• John 8:12 • Hebrews 10:11–12 • Revelation 5:8 • Leviticus 16

THREE MOVEMENTS

- **Courtyard** (God draws near): God confronts sin, provides a substitute, and welcomes us back through the Lamb (John 1:29; Rom. 5:8–9).
- **Holy Place** (God keeps us near): God sustains closeness—bread for daily life, light for guidance, incense for prayer (John 6:51; John 8:12; Rev. 5:8).
- **Most Holy Place** (God seals our oneness with Him): God cleanses and restores—at-one-ment, making a people ready for the wedding (Lev. 16:30 ; Heb. 10:11–12).

QUESTIONS

- Where am I pushing God away right now—through a habit, a fear, or a hidden compromise?
- What would it look like today to come to Jesus as the Lamb—honest, repentant, and grateful?
- Which “holy place practice” do I most need right now: Scripture (bread), obedience/light, or prayer/incense?
- Is there anything I’m resisting that God is trying to cleanse, heal, or set right in me?
- How would my week change if I lived like I’m being prepared for a wedding—not just surviving a schedule?

THIS WEEK: 1 prayer ♦ 1 word ♦ 1 act

Pray: *“Jesus, draw near to me. Keep me near to You. Make me clean and ready for Your wedding day.”*

Word: NEAR — He comes near, keeps us near, and will have us forever near.

Act: Take one sanctuary step today: (1) Confess and thank Jesus for the Lamb’s sacrifice; (2) Spend 10 minutes with bread + light + incense (one Scripture, one surrendered worry, one honest prayer); (3) Ask God to cleanse what needs cleansing.

ONE CONVICTION FROM TODAY’S SERMON:

PRAYER

*Jesus, draw near to me. Keep me near to You.
Make me clean and ready for Your wedding day.*
